



## 2019 Southern Texas PGA Foundation Scholarship Program Application Procedures & Checklist

Applications are available online [here](#) beginning **Thursday January 3, 2019** and are accepted until **Friday, March 22, 2019**. To be considered for a STPGA Foundation Scholarship, the application must be completed in its entirety. The information supplied must be accurate and will be kept strictly confidential by the STPGA Foundation.

All supporting documents below will need to be submitted in one (1) PDF, except for transcripts, by Friday, March 22, 2019. They must be in order and labeled as **(lastname\_firstname\_last4digitsofSSN)**. Please submit via email to Kailee Neumann at [kneumann@pgahq.com](mailto:kneumann@pgahq.com) no later than 11:59 p.m. CST on Friday, March 22, 2019. **Applications will not be processed without the following documents. No .JPGs of supporting documents will be accepted.**

- Resume**
  - Junior Golf participation (if applicable), honors, awards, extracurricular activities, and work experience should be group logically into categories, as in resume form.
- Personal Statement**
  - Include a personal statement of no more than 500 words expressing how your school experiences, academics, extracurricular activities, and work experiences are shaping your educational and career goals, why you should be considered for scholarship support, and any financial or other information you wish to share that may be of importance to the selection committee.
- Letter(s) of Recommendation**
  - This can be from a golf professional, employer, high school coach, teacher at your school, or anyone other than a family member who can tell us why you are especially deserving of this award.
- ACT and/or SAT scores (High School Applicants Only)**
- Student Aid Report (SAR) and Expected Family Contribution (EFC) information**
  - You will receive your SAR and EFC information when you complete your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Please note that the FAFSA is available at libraries, colleges, universities, and online at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov). You should fill out the FAFSA and submit your information between February 1 – February 15. You will receive the SAR approximately four weeks after you file your FAFSA.
- Transcript**
  - Transcript should be from Fall Semester of 2018-19 school year
  - Transcripts can be emailed to Kailee Neumann at [kneumann@pgahq.com](mailto:kneumann@pgahq.com) no later than 11:59 p.m. CST on Friday, March 22, 2019.
